



Futrend Technology Awarded NIH CIO-SP3 GWAC Contract

Company Will Donate Profit Percentage to Charity

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Vienna, Va. – July 12, 2012 – Futrend Technology, Inc. (FUTREND) announced today that it has been awarded a National Institutes of Health (NIH) Chief Information Officer – Solutions and Partners 3 (CIO-SP3) Government Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) under both the 8(a) and small business groupings.

CIO-SP3 is a 10-year, \$20 billion federal government-wide acquisition contract supporting federal government information technology initiatives focusing on health- and biomedical-related services. It is a successor to the highly successful CIO-SP2i and the Image World2 New Dimensions GWAC contracts.
